# A Meditation for January

Pastor Jon Gougeon

Wow, here it is January 2023, where did the year go? Many things have happened around the world and in our lives. We pause in retrospect and think about all the events that took place in the past year. But the past is past and we look to the future with the hope of a new year of living with and in Christ. Let us with renewed hopes press onward to the goal, that is eternal life with Christ as Paul says, "but this one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, <sup>14</sup> I press on toward the goal for the prize of the heavenly call of God in Christ Jesus." Phil 3:13-14 (NRSV)

This is traditionally the time for making resolutions that will make a us healthier, happier, or a better person. Personally, I am not a fan of this approach, for it is my experience that only through faith in Jesus Christ, and repentance from sin will the God of the universe indwell us with the Holy Spirit and create change in our lives. We really cannot do it ourselves.

So let us consider some small steps of renewal of our faith, our hope and our love. First off, let us set aside a portion of time each day to spend with the Lord. It can be reading the bible, praying, or just quietly listening for God's word for us. Start with 10 minutes and work from there.

Let us try to see all other people as Christ sees them, with a concern that we might make their day a bit better for having come in contact with us. To do this we can remember John Wesley's three simple rules:

Do no Harm. Do Good. Stay in love with God.


